The high speed internet Connection with Cal-net (formerly Mother.com) is on line and working Great! Be sure to check with John for the new password.

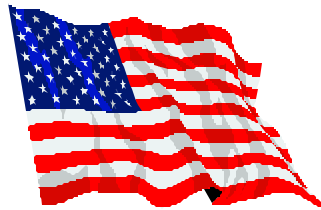
